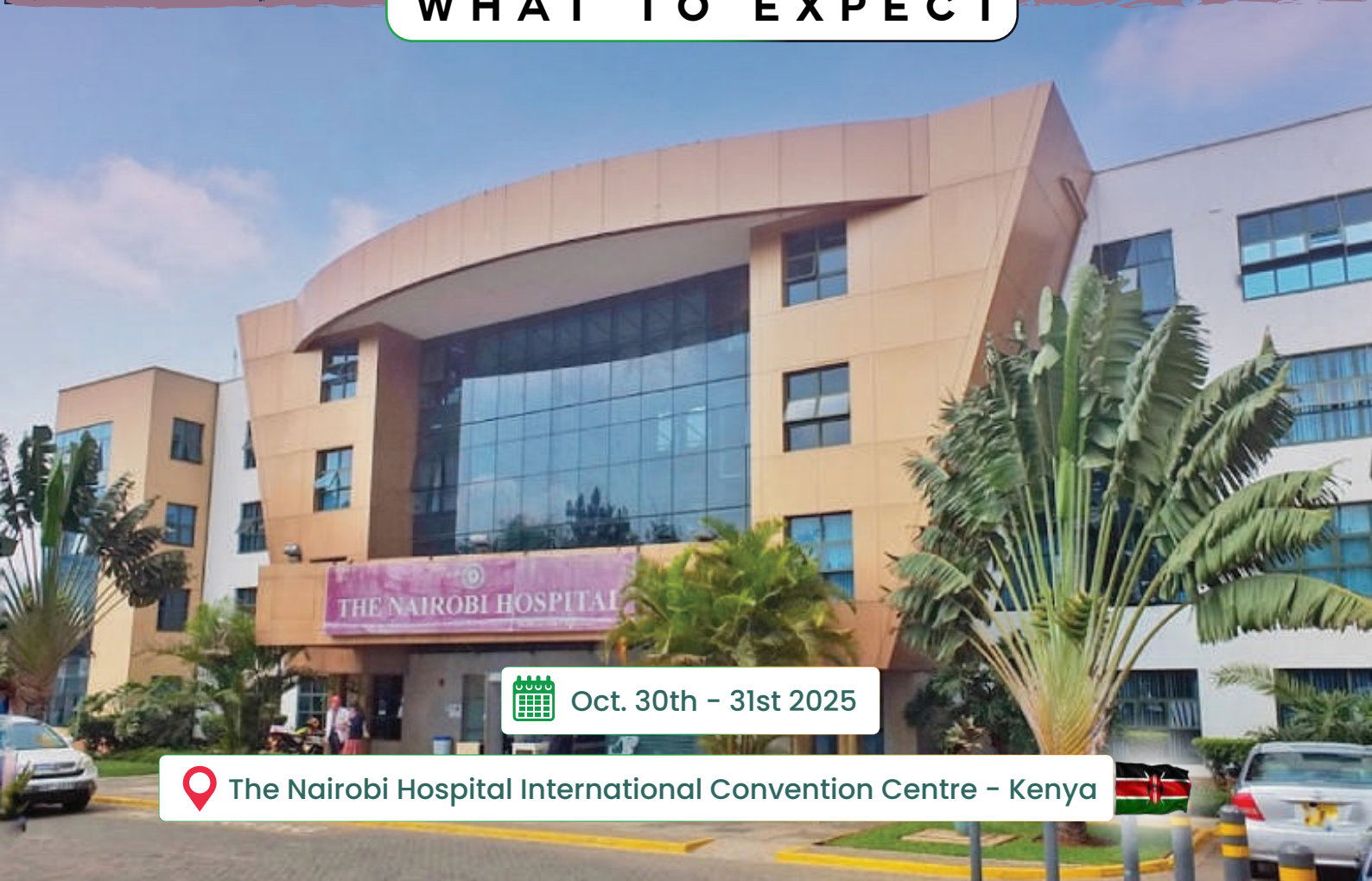

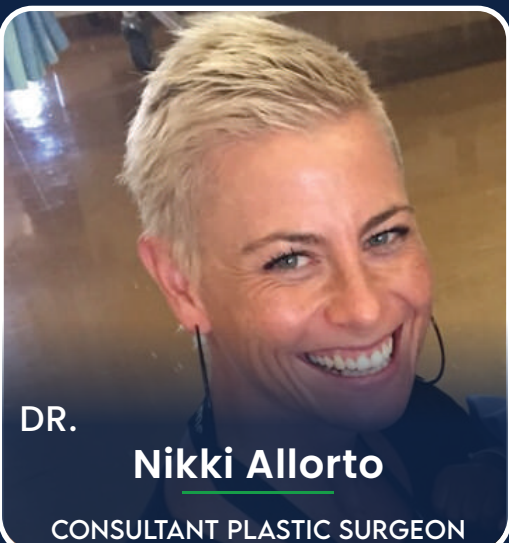


Meet Dr. Björn

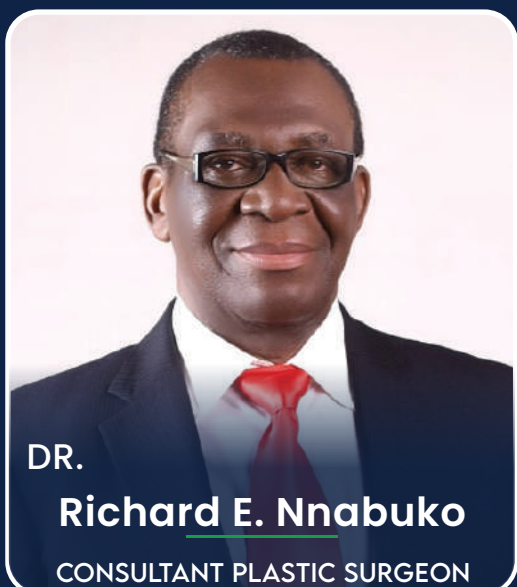


Meet Prof. Nangole

He leads the Plastic Surgery thematic unit at the University of Nairobi. As one of Kenya's leading plastic surgeons, he performs a wide range of procedures. He has earned several honors, including awards for his presentations at international and local conferences and the 2013 EBOPRAS fellowship achievement.

He is also instrumental in establishing plastic surgery training and micro-vascular surgery at the University of Nairobi and has supervised over thirty MMed students and a PhD student. Prof. Nangole is the current President of the Kenya Society of Plastic, Reconstructive, and Aesthetic Surgeons.

Meet Dr. Nnabuko

Dr. Richard E. Nnabuko, a Consultant Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon since 1993 at National Orthopaedic Hospital, Enugu, Nigeria, has focused on burn care since 1985. He has trained professionals at the National Postgraduate Medical College of Nigeria and West African College of Surgeons since 2004 and helped develop the Burns and Plastic Nursing Program in 2006.

He served as President of the Pan African Burn Society (2013-2017), Nigerian Burn Society (2005-2007), and Nigerian Association of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeons (2007-2009). He was ISBI Africa Representative (2013-2016), ISBI Program Chair (2016-2018), and WHO EMT Burns Committee member (2016-2019). A faculty member of Interburns (2011-2016) and Board of Trustees member since 2018, he is a wound care specialist and serves on editorial boards of burns and plastic surgery journals.

Professor Adelin Muganza, MD, FCS (SA), FRCSI, FCS (ECS), FACS, is a General Surgeon and Director of the Burn Unit at Chris Hani Baragwanath Academic Hospital, University of the Witwatersrand, South Africa. He became a specialist surgeon in 2003 (College of Surgeons of South Africa), a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland (2022), American College of Surgeons (2016), and East, Central, and Southern Africa College of Surgeons (2023).

A prolific author and international speaker, his research focuses on new technologies and skin substitutes for burn injuries and promoting basic surgical skills in Africa. He is the past President of the South African Burns Society, Secretary and Treasurer of the American College of Surgeons (South African Chapter), and a leader in Global Surgery, aiming to improve surgical care in low-income countries. Currently, he heads the Department of Surgery at Chris Hani Baragwanath Academic Hospital in Johannesburg.

Mark Fisher

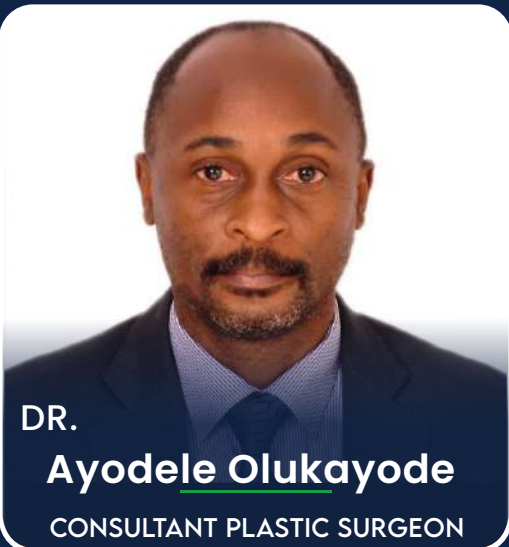
CONSULTANT PLASTIC SURGEON

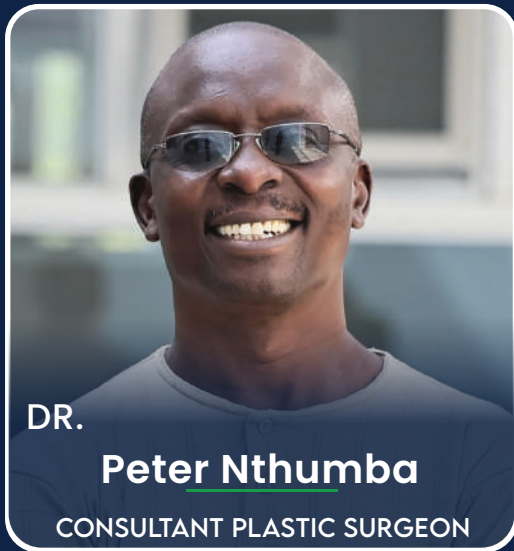
